The 2006 Sucé Twinning Visit

Saturday 6 May and Sunday 7 May

Well the 2006 visit is almost upon us. We have just about found homes for all the visitors and sorted out the arrangements for the weekend.

The schedule has changed somewhat. The plane our visitors are coming on was cancelled and they were bumped onto a later flight.

So now instead of coming to Cricklade and then going on somewhere else, the French will be stopping at Oxford on the way from Heathrow.

The coach will arrive in Oxford at about 12.30. Lunch which may be a picnic depending on the weather. There will be time to do some shopping etc.

At 2.30, we will meet near Christchurch College for a tour of Oxford. This will start with a visit to Christchurch and then round to see the rest of historic Oxford. The tour will end at about 4.30. *Please note there are only 38 places on the tour, so there are very few places for hosts on the tour*

The coach will then proceed to Cricklade **arriving at 5.30pm**. For those of you who opted not to come to Oxford, we will phone ahead with a more precise time of arrival.

The rest of Saturday will be hosts and visitors to enjoy themselves, but please don't forget that our visitors will have had a very early start to the day.

We have changed the schedule for Sunday, so now we won't be doing a Safari lunch, but will be doing a traditional English tea at the Town Hall. We hope to have live music and you may even be able to a bit of dancing.

After tea, there will be a themed walk around Cricklade, which should be a lot of fun. We are keeping the details under wraps.

The evening activities should be concluded by 7.30 to 8.00, so you should have a little time with your guests, who will be **leaving Cricklade at 8.30am on Monday 8th May**.

The coach will take our guests to London for a day's outing prior to dropping them at Heathrow at 4pm in time for the 6pm flight to Nantes via Charles de Gaulle.

If you are not hosting a French family, you are welcome to come to the Tea in the Town Hall (please however complete the form below so we can track numbers). A small charge of £5 will be levied on all natives attending, but this should be well worth while as the tea is being professionally catered.
