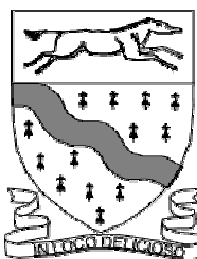

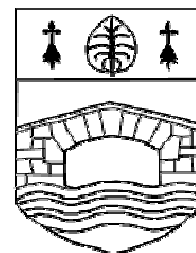

Twinning Visit Friday 8 – Monday 11 May 2009

Only a week to go before we lucky few will be heading out to Sucé. We will be flying out of Southampton to Rennes on the BE1025 at 10.35am.

The coach subject to better advice will leave Cricklade at 7.00am on Friday from in front of the Town Hall. On arriving at Rennes a fleet of cars will collect us and take us to Sucé arriving at around 2pm French time. On the way back we will leave Sucé at a time dependent on the local recommendation to catch the BE1026 13.00hr plane from Rennes to Southampton. We will arrive at Southampton at 1300hrs and so should be back in Cricklade by 1500hrs.
