



Safari Supper Saturday 10th October

For anyone who doesn't know – our Safari supper works like this.

1. Everyone one meets at 98 Deansfield for a drink.

The bit that's missing is that hosts are needed to provide starters and the main course. Each host will entertain four to six people for their course.

The cost of participation is £10 a head, with hosts getting a substantial discount.
