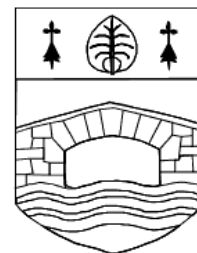

Twinning Visit 2013

23th-27th May

The Twinning visit will be on the weekend of 23rd to 27th of May – the Spring Bank Holiday. So put the date in your diary - we will be starting to work on travel options.

We have booked the ferry and coach for next year – what we need now is for you to sign up and pay a deposit of £25.

The basic itinerary is out overnight Portsmouth Caen on Thursday 23rd May back Cherbourg Caen (fast ferry) on Monday 27th.

We would encourage everyone to travel this way as it reduces costs and is a great chance to get to know each other.

However we do understand that some people really do not enjoy sailing so we are also looking for options to fly or go by train independently.

COSTS

The initial cost is set at £120 for adults, £60 for children.

Cabins on the outbound overnight leg are an additional £60 for a 4 berth and £40 for 2 berth; we have two 4 berth, and several 2 berth cabins so first come etc.

In the event of our over recovering the costs, we will refund everyone pro-rata.
