It all over now. I hope everyone really enjoyed themselves and has let us know about anything that didn't go so well.


The tour of White Horses, Avebury and Marlborough went well with lovely weather. Followed by the Civic Reception and the Somme Drumhead Service

Hampton Court was a big hit, although with a little bit of lost people and a few folks getting rained on. There was also the odd shoe failure.


