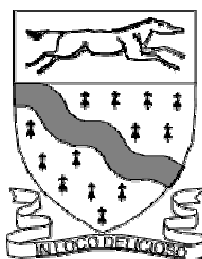

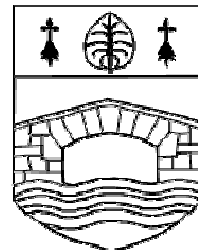

Twinning Visit 2010 18th – 20th June

Fifty French Guests are visiting Cricklade this year for what is the 20th Anniversary of the first exchange visit under the Twinning Charter agreed between the two towns.

The 2010 visit to Cricklade is taking place over the weekend of 19th to 20th June to coincide with the Cricklade Festival.

The Schedule

Friday 18h15 French arrive in Cricklade having arrived by coach and ferry and having spent some hours exploring Salisbury.

Friday 18h30 Reception hosted by Cricklade Town Council – following the reception get to know your guests and supper.

Saturday 07h30 We are off to Longleat. We aim to be back in Cricklade by 17h30. We will be taking two coaches to Longleat. In a change from normal practice, the trip will be free to both Hosts and Guests. Twinning associates not hosting may join the trip at £10.00 each (still heavily subsidised). We have organised a guided tour with French speaking guides of the house, however many of us will not be able to participate because we only have 40 places (sounded lots when we first set it up). Everyone else can go round on their own. Trips round the Safari Park will be organised, although the Coach won't take on the monkeys.

Sunday 10h30 Reception to celebrate our Twentieth Anniversary with the Cricklade Singers, nibbles and drinks, which should merge into the Cricklade Festival

Sunday 17h30 The French depart
